> TAFE Queensland provides a range of services to help support members to re-enter the workforce after exiting the Australian Defence Force (ADF). There are a range of funding options that ex-ADF members may be eligible for that can reduce the costs of their studies.

TAFE Queensland's Defence to Civilian Transition Training (DCTT) provides training and career solutions for ADF members transitioning to civilian life across Australia.

Transitioning ADF members can be faced with significant challenges adapting into civilian life. The aim of the DCTT project is to provide informed, consistent and a national approach to address these challenges.

Discuss your transition options with an experienced ex-ADF and TAFE Queensland Defence Solutions Officer (DSO) to see what options are available. Our Defence team can help guide veterans and ADF members through the transition process.

The role of the TAFE Queensland DSO is to interpret the members' specific Defence skills and connect them through the national TAFE network to further develop a training plan.

The TAFE Queensland DSO has significant background in Defence, personal ADF transition and experience as a VET trade teacher. The DSO offers support, advice and guidance and can discuss recognition of prior learning defence training and can provide a range of funding options to support the adjustment to meaningful civilian opportunities.

VET programs are delivered online, face to face or a blend of both, and information is relayed to the Defence member through a TAFE Director Australia (TDA) nominated contact in each state/territory or TAFE campus.

This approach advocates for local TAFE/VET delivery and transition leads will be distributed based on scope and a member's training preference. This helps in states/territories where TAFE/VET campuses have not yet merged into one registered training organisation.

Additional features of the DCTT Project's innovation structure are;

- Reduced wait times
- Decreased stress for ADF members and their families
- Surety when developing a life beyond the military.

This project recognises and supports ADF members and mentors other TAFE's to provide a united and holistic approach to build a skills profile for all transitioning Defence members.
